ISSUE: Article X, Section 1:
SMART Local 177 & U.S. Engineering

Gentlemen:

The National Joint Adjustment Board (NJAB) met in Salt Lake City, Utah on September 9-10, 2019 to consider the grievance filed by SMART Local 177 against U.S. Engineering. Tony Easley and Steve Goolsby appeared on behalf of the Local Union. Brendan Rittal, Justin Apprill and Bryan Taylor appeared on behalf of U.S. Engineering.

A review of the record demonstrated that all procedural requirements had been met. The matter, therefore, was properly before the NJAB for decision.

The NJAB, after thoroughly reviewing the record, reached the following unanimous decision: The case is postponed while U.S. Engineering produces information requested by Local 177, and Local 177 produces information requested by U.S. Engineering, pursuant to an off-the-record agreement between the parties. The production is to be made by October 10, 2019. The Co-Chairs will appoint a subcommittee consisting of two management and two labor members of the NJAB which shall hear the case as soon as practical after the parties agree that the information productions are complete.
